Approved modifications of the programme after the last Cooperation Committee meeting

Modifications of the Programme Agreement

Two amendments of the Programme Agreement for the Home Affairs Programme have been approved by FMO since the last Cooperation Committee meeting on September 1st, 2020

- 1. Modification applied after 21.02.2021:
 - Approval of the inclusion of a new open call on "Improving the national asylum and migration capacities, especially as regards vulnerable migrants";
 - Approval of the inclusion of the new pre-defined project (PDP) 8 "Development of the cooperation in the Schengen area"
- 2. Modification applied after 25.05.2021:
 - Project level co-financing requirement for NGOs is waived, allowing for a grant rate up to 100% in case of support to NGOs in order to free up resources for NGOs, and remove pressure to raise funds during the Covid-19;
 - This change is based on a letter of the Chairman of FMO from 20 April 2020 whereas Programme Operators and National Focal Points were suggested measures on how to mitigate possible effects of Covid-19 on programme implementation.

GRANT AMOUNT AND GRANT RATE

Amount available for the call – 4 000 000 EURO (7 823 200 BGN).

The call will be launched with a budget of 3 000 000 EURO (5 867 400 BGN). Amount for projects on the reserve list - 1 000 000 EURO (1 955 800 BGN).

Per project:

- Maximum grant amount 1 000 000 EURO (1 955 800 BGN).
- Minimum grant amount 200 000 EURO (391 160 BGN).



ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES (non exhaustive list)

Component 1

- Functioning (renovation, equipment, maintenance, operational costs, etc.)of the reception facilities for vulnerable asylum seekers with focus on UAMs;
- Provision of social, health, educational and legal services to the vulnerable asylum seekers with focus on UAMs;
- Health measures provided to asylum seekers with special focus on vulnerable groups;



ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES (non exhaustive list)

Component 2

- Capacity building of national institutions, NGOs and international organizations in the field of asylum and migration;
- Development and implementation of specific procedures and standards for referral, reception, care and guardianship/representation of UAMs;
- Trainings of staff of relevant stakeholders to enhance knowledge, expertise and management skills to support and protect vulnerable asylum seekers with focus on UAMs
- Strengthening cooperation among national institutions and NGOs working with migrants and asylum seekers;
- Elaboration of proposals for further development of the policy and the legal framework in the field of asylum and migration;
- Knowledge exchange and exchange of best practice between Bulgarian and Norwegian entities, especially on the organisation of reception facilities, on case management systems and on vulnerable groups and specifically UAMs;



INDICATORS

- Elaboration of Phrasebook/Manual/Video clips to deal with unaccompanied minors and vulnerable groups
- Development of functional analysis of SAR
- Construction works, delivery of furniture/equipment for seminars rooms (4) in SAR premises
- Seminars (10) for CDBP officers in counteracting trafficking in human beings and working with representatives of vulnerable groups
- Trainings (3) and study visits (2) for MD officers.

- Revision of training schedule. Some trainings will be moved online (language trainings).
- Elaboration of Technical specifications for public procurement is ongoing





- Delivery of presentation and IT equipment for the IOCD officials


Current state of play

PDP 6: Improving the capacity of police and judicial activity dealing with material evidence in pre-trial investigation process

Implementation period: 36 months (as of December, 18 2019)

Main activities under the project	 Delivery of 10 fully equipped mobile forensic laboratories; Trainings for police officers; Renovation of premises for material evidence storage and delivery of equipment; Development of an automated system for registration and tracking of seized evidence.
Current state of play	 Procurement procedure has been completed and contract signature under each of the lots – vehicles, equipment and 3D scanners. Launch of procedures for trainings organization, translation and interpretation and supply of airplane tickets is forthcoming. To overcome delay the Promoter considers the holding seminars on-line. Out of the ten procurement procedures one is completed and a contract has been signed, three are ongoing and six are to be launched. The Promotor has submitted a request for modification – additional experts to develop terms of reference and budget modification (increase of funds).






Financial Implementation



Updated risk management table

Changes in the risk management table

As agreed in the last Cooperation Committee meeting and in accordance with the approved minutes, PO made the following changes:

- 1. "Lack of communication between the responsible units" as proposed by UDI the risk was revised to "lack of regular, up to date and timely communication between the responsible units";
- 2. The score of the likelihood of the risk "Delay in the implementation of the Programme may represent a risk for the successful achievement of its objectives" was 2 (unlikely) and updated to 3 (likely) due to some minor delays following the Covid-19 situation;
- 3. The risk scores of the risk "Delays in implementation of projects, incl. public procurement procedures due to COVID-19 situation" were: 4 (almost certain) for likelihood and 2 (moderate) for consequence. However, there are no significant delays in project implementation so the risk score was decreased to 3 (likely);
- 4. New risks related to the new open call and the new PDP 8 were added.
