- Outcome 1–Transfer of knowledge for the management of the cultural heritage and the entrepreneurship in the area of culture;
- Outcome 2 –Joint events prepared through bilateral cooperation such as artistic and cultural productions (including tours), exhibition tours, study-visits and others;

- Outcome 3 –Promotion of the customs and the culture of the cultural minorities and contribution to the integration processes;

Criteria for a good project partnership

- Letter /Intention for a partnership;
- Partnership Agreement;
- Balance in the implementation of the activities;
- Shared budget– opportunity for spending of the funding by all legal entities in the partnership;
- Accountability;



Support for study-visits– Travel Support Scheme

- Permanently active Call for proposals;
- 100 000 €;
- Easy application and approval;
- Easy verification of the expenditures;
