Project description: After studying the experiences of other countries in the region with similar social and economic development, the project will develop innovative data generation methods needed to formulate policy-relevant solutions for policy makers at regional and local level.

The main objective of the project is to test and implement the identified data collection methods that will be used in decision-making, the planning of adequate social policies, the development of targets for operational programs, and the monitoring of the implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG).

It is envisaged to gather detailed information on at least 10,000 households and to produce four thematic reports on the situation of children, people with disabilities, the elderly and the Roma, and one report focusing on ways of sharing data and using them in judging policies.
