Project description: The general objective of project "Youth Center Dobrich - Your tomorrow!" is to expand the territorial scope of Youth Center Dobrich and improve the quality and variety of activities, increase the number of participants of different ages in the activities of the Center in response to the needs and desires of youth and community members including those from vulnerable groups (groups at higher risk of poverty and social exclusion from the general population, ethnic minorities, people with disabilities, children and pupils who have dropped out of the education system, children and young people without parents or with only one parent, children and youth coming from low-educated families or struggling with substance abuse, unemployed).

Specific objectives: to expand the territorial scope of the Youth Center by working in the field and providing a greater variety of activities to reach children and youth living in remote and small settlements in the district who have no access to such services; increase the number of services provided in response to the identified needs of young people in the region; promote the active participation of youth and increase the number of activities organized at the initiative of young people; participation of people from different age groups, i.e. children, parents, teachers, experts working with youth, etc.; create an inclusive and safe environment in the Center, create an attitude of mutual respect for each other and tolerance for differences; improve the quality of the existing services and activities, which will create an inspiring environment for the development of social, educational and cultural activities through appropriate spaces and facilitated interaction between representatives of different groups; intercultural dialogue and sharing of good practices; mobility, flexibility and improved access to services; provide opportunities for exchange of experience with organizations from donor countries and European partners, and participation in joint campaigns, initiatives and trainings of the National Network of Youth Centers.
